

Dear Brothers & Sisters,

In an effort to keep everyone safe in the work place, please follow these safety precautions and ALL commonsense safety habits.

SAFE RIGGING:

1. Never use carabiners with working lines unless they have **auto locking** keepers.
2. Never use your working carabiner in conjunction with any other device, tool or apparatus.
3. High riggers should always be clipped in and your safety apparatus must not have other devices or tools attached to it. I.e. don't use your fall arrester for tool storage.
4. Double check your knots.
5. Do NOT rush – SAFETY FIRST

FORKLIFT-SCISSOR LIFT-BOOM LIFT SAFETY:

1. Always assume the driver does NOT see you. Especially with fork drivers.
2. Load in & load outs can be chaotic at times. Be aware of the forklift and the forks, whether turning, stacking-unstacking, keep a safe distance from potential harm.
3. Lift drivers should always be clipped in.
4. Drivers should always be aware of personnel around them. Look 360 degrees before every movement.
5. Do Not use the lift personnel cage as a lifting mechanism.

Look out for each other. You've heard this before; "If you see something, say something" and stay SAFE!
